Seaford Secondary College caters for students from 7-12. At the time of this report, the enrolment in 2025 is 829. Seaford Secondary College is classified as Category 3 on the Department for Education Index of Educational Disadvantage. At the time of this report, the school population includes 7% Aboriginal students, 14% students with disabilities, 3% students with English as an additional language or dialect (EALD) funded background, 3% children/young people in care. 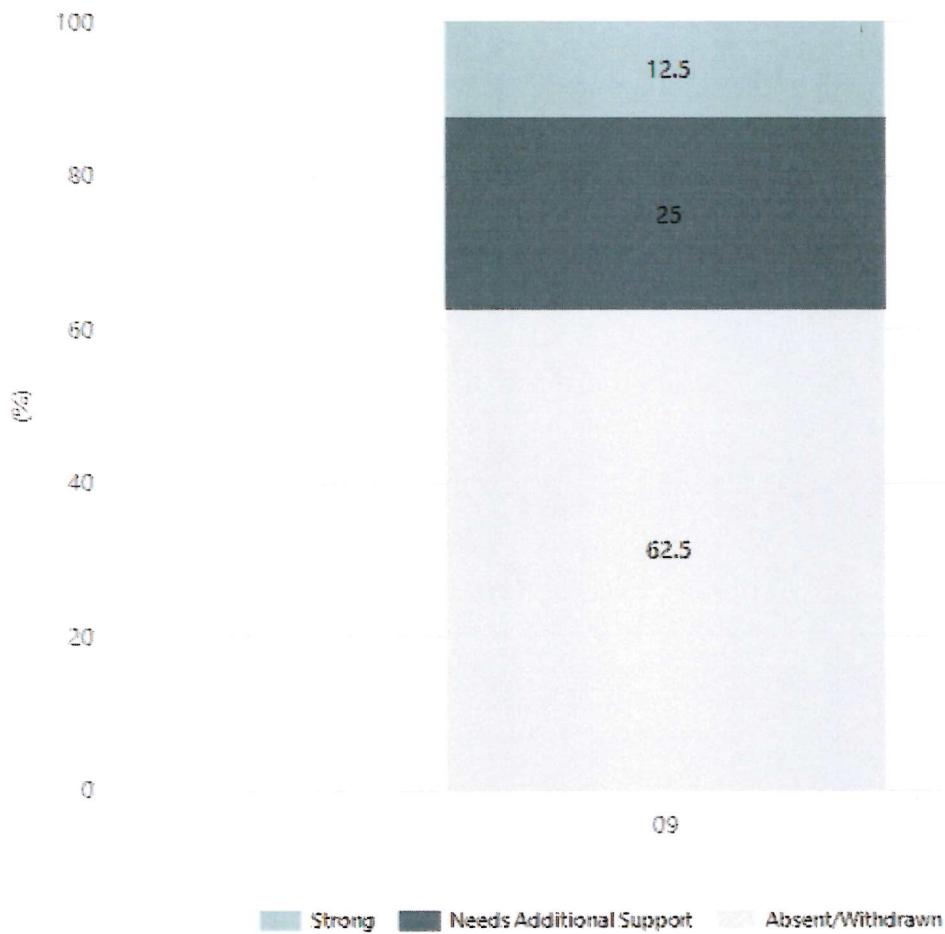
